

Take & Make

Tissue Paper Art!

Materials Provided:

- Watercolor Paper
- White Crayon
- Tissue Paper
- Spritz Bottle

Additional Materials Needed:

- Water



Directions

- Choose whether you'd like to use the crayon resist for your project. If so, first you will draw a design (words, patterns, etc.) with white crayon on the watercolor paper. If not, skip to the next step.
 - NOTE: Because you are drawing white on white, your drawing won't be visible until the final step.
- Pre-wet the watercolor panel by spraying it with the spray bottle filled with water.
- Apply the tissue paper squares randomly or in a planned arrangement.
- I recommend spraying some more water over the squares to accelerate the color "bleeding".
- For best results, allow the water to dry before removing the squares.
- Once you remove the squares, the color will have transferred onto the watercolor panel, revealing your drawing and the color from the squares!
