

Take & Make

Capiz Wind Chimes!

Materials Provided:

- 32 Capiz Shells
 - 16 Large Shells
 - 16 Small Shells
- Mason Jar Lid
- 8 Pre-Cut Pieces of Thread
- Twine

Additional Materials Needed:

- Scissors
- Super Glue/Hot Glue Gun



Directions

- The wind chime will have 8 strings with 4 shells per string.
 - I suggest 2 gold and 2 light green shells per string, but you can split them up however you'd like.
- Take a piece of thread and loop it through one of the shells. Secure with a double knot. (Picture 1)
- Add the remaining 3 shells one at a time and knot them in place as you go (I single knotted these). (Picture 2)
 - You want to leave a small space between the shells. (Picture 3)



- Once you have all 8 strings threaded with the shells, it's time to tie them to the lid.
- Double knot the string around the band of the lid and then trim any excess.
- Secure in place with a small amount of super glue (hot glue gun would work too).
 - I place the glue right at the point of the knot to make sure it doesn't come undone.



- Fold the twine and thread it through the pre-drilled hole in the lid and knot it in place. Be sure to trim any excess twine.
- Pop the inner part of the lid back into place and hang and enjoy!
