

# Take & Make

## Mason Jar Luminary!

### Materials Provided:

- Mason Jar
- Maple Leaf Vinyl Sticker
- Acrylic Paint
- Foam Paint Brush
- Twine
- Pebbles
- Tea Light

### Additional Materials Needed:

- Tweezers
- Small Paint Brush



### Directions

- Apply the cut vinyl maple leaf to the smooth side of the mason jar.
- Begin painting a thin coat of paint on the mason jar.
  - Be sure you allow the paint to dry completely between each coat.
  - It took about 3-4 coats for it to be completely covered.
- Once the mason jar is dry, gently peel away the vinyl leaf sticker.
  - I used tweezers to help with this process. As you peel away the sticker, some of the paint on the jar might start to peel off too, you can go back and touch up any rough edges with a small paintbrush (not provided).
  - You could also try peeling off the sticker before the paint is completely dry...but since that's not how I did it, I'm not sure if it's easier or not.
- Pour in the pebbles and place the tea light inside.
  - You can skip the pebbles if you want, but I liked the detail they added!
- Finish it off with some twine around the top!
