Macramé Keychains!

Materials Provided:

- 1 Key Chain Ring
- 12 ft. Light Blue Macramé
- 1 ft. of Light Blue Macramé
- 4 Wooden Beads

Additional Materials Needed:

- Tape
- Scissors



Before You Start:

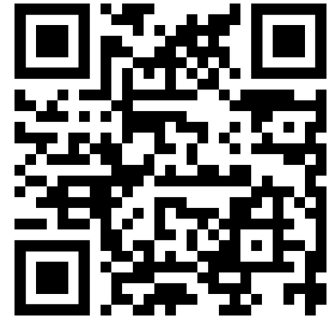
- The 12 ft. piece of macramé can be cut into shorter strings that will be woven together to make your keychain.
- The 1 ft. piece of macramé can be used to create a wrap-knot to tie off your keychain (if the pattern you use requires one).
- Taping the keychain to a table is very helpful while you're working so it doesn't move around on you!

Selecting Your Pattern:

- These are a few patterns and tutorials that I would recommend:
 - Seashell (<https://youtu.be/ud41B1oRs3c>)
 - Four 30-inch (2.5 ft.) strings
 - One 10-inch string for a wrap-knot
 - Mermaid Tail (<https://youtu.be/LFOQy8SzHwM>)
 - Three 48-inch (4 ft.) strings
 - One 10-inch string for a wrap-knot
 - Tassel (<https://youtu.be/1nxtPXgVctg>)
 - Five 16-inch strings
 - Remove the ring from the ring from the keychain clasp
 - Beaded (<https://youtu.be/swIFibc87GU>)
 - Four 34-inch strings
 - One 10-inch string for a wrap-knot
