

Take & Make

Rock Photo Holders!



Materials Provided:

- Rock
- Craft Wire

Additional Materials Needed:

- Paint or Markers
- Mod Podge (OPTIONAL)
- Beads (OPTIONAL)
- Pliers and/or wire cutters



Directions:

- The rocks are quite dusty, so it's recommended that you wash them first and allow them to dry.
- Paint or color your rock however you wish!
 - To help preserve the color of your paint or markers you can add a thin layer of Mod Podge for sealant.
- Wrap the wire around the rock. You might have to be creative and pick which directions will hold the wire best!
 - OPTION 1 (recommended): Take the end of the wire and hold it on top of the rock. Wrap the wire around the rock one time. Twist the wire together with your fingers first and then carefully tighten with pliers so the wire doesn't slip off.



- OPTION 2: Take the end of the wire and hold it on the bottom of the rock. Wrap the wire around the rock 2-3 times. Miss Bree personally likes the look of this method better, but struggled to get the wire to fit tightly around the rock.
- After wrapping the wire around the rock you should have about 7-8 inches of free wire. Feel free to shorten the wire if necessary.
- If you want you can string some beads onto the wire for decoration. Be sure to leave about 3 inches of wire at the top.
- Wrap a wire around a pen or marker a few times to make some loops. This is where the photo will be held.
