a. <u>Resolution 21-59</u>: <u>Update of Town's Voting Precincts</u> (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-59 - Majority Vote)

**ACTION:** The Town Council made a motion to approve Resolution 21-59, to update the Town's voting precincts. *Approved 8-0* 

b. <u>Resolution 21-60: Further Amending the Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-off Abatement</u> <u>Program</u> (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-60 - Majority Vote)

**ACTION:** The Town Council made a motion to approve Resolution 21-60, to further amend the Senior Citizen Property Tax Work-off Abatement Program. *Approved 8-0* 

c. <u>Resolution 21-61: Further Amending the Veterans' Property Tax Work-off Abatement Program</u> (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-61 - Majority Vote)

**ACTION:** The Town Council made a motion to approve Resolution 21-61, to further amend the Veterans' Property Tax Work-off Abatement Program. *Approved 8-0* 

d. <u>Resolution 21-62: Acceptance of G.L. Chapter 59, Section 5C ½ and Increase in Certain</u> <u>Property Tax Exemptions Pursuant Thereto</u> (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-62 - Majority Vote)

**ACTION:** The Town Council made a motion to approve Resolution 21-62, to accept G.L. Chapter 59, Section 5C  $\frac{1}{2}$  and increase certain property tax exemptions pursuant thereto. *Approved 8-0* 

e. <u>Resolution 21-63: Cable Funds in Support of PEG Service and Programming per MGL Ch. 44,</u> <u>§53F3/4 - \$28,000 (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-63 - Majority Vote)</u>

**ACTION:** The Council made a motion to approve resolution 21-63. The Massachusetts Department of Revenue requires the Town Council to vote to appropriate PEG funds received from Verizon to an established revolving account. This resolution appropriated \$28,000 in PEG funds, representing the agreed annual amount for capital improvements in the first five years of the Town's agreement with Verizon, to the Franklin Cable Access Corporation per M.G.L Ch.4, §53F3/4. *Approved 8-0* 

f. <u>Resolution 21-64: Cable Funds in Support of PEG Service and Programming per MGL Ch. 44,</u> <u>§53F3/4 - \$28,000</u> (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-64 - Majority Vote)

**ACTION:** The Council made a motion to approve resolution 21-64. The Massachusetts Department of Revenue requires the Town Council to vote to appropriate PEG funds received from Verizon to an established revolving account. This resolution appropriated \$28,000 in PEG funds from a prior fiscal year, representing the agreed annual amount for capital improvements

in the first five years of the Town's agreement with Verizon, to the Franklin Cable Access Corporation per M.G.L Ch.4, §53F3/4. *Approved 8-0*
