10. LEGISLATION FOR ACTION

a. Resolution 21-68: Gift Acceptance - Veterans' Dept (\$1,000), Historical Commission (\$100) (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-68 - Majority Vote)

ACTION: The Town Council accepted an exceptionally generous gift on behalf of the Veterans' Services Department (\$1,000) which will be allocated toward the Veterans' Municipal Assistance Fund, and an exceptionally generous gift on behalf of the Historical Commission (\$100) which will be applied towards the preservation, protection, and development of historic and archaeological assets of Franklin. **Approved 9-0.**

b. Resolution 21-69: General Funds Appropriation, Transfers and Adjustments FY22 (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-69 - Majority Vote)

ACTION: The Town Council approved Resolution 21-69 to transfer and adjust FY22 General Fund appropriations that in total amount to a reduction in the FY22 General Fund operating budget of Four Hundred Fifty-Four Thousand Six Hundred Seventy-Two Dollars (\$454,672). *Approved 9-0.*

c. <u>Resolution 21-70: Appropriation of Cannabis Fees</u>
(Motion to Approve Resolution 21-70 - Majority Vote)

ACTION: The Town Council approved Resolution 21-70 to raise and appropriate the sum of Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) to offset the negative impacts of the sale of cannabis in the Town of Franklin, said amount representing the total to be received from cannabis impact Fees in FY22. *Approved 8-0. Abstained-1 (Councilor Dellorco).*

d. Resolution 21-71: Appropriation to Pay Prior Years' Bills
(Motion to Approve Resolution 21-71 - 3/3 Majority Vote)

ACTION: The Town Council approved Resolution 21-71 to appropriate FY22 funds in the amount of One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars and Forty-Eight Cents (\$1,279.48) to pay for prior years' bills in accordance with G.L. Ch44, §64. *Approved 9-0*.

- e. Resolution 21-72: Order of Taking Approximately Seventy (70) Acres of Unimproved Land Off Maple Street (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-72 3/3 Majority Vote)
 - **ACTION:** The Town Council approved Resolution 21-72 to take by eminent domain approximately seventy (70) acres of unimproved land off Maple Street for municipal purposes, namely open space and passive recreation. This vote is the final step required to ensure a good title for the Maple Hill property. **Approved 9-0.**
- f. Resolution 21-73: Acceptance of Open Space, Access and Parking Easements at Brookview Condominium Located Off Pond Street (Motion to Approve Resolution 21-73 Majority Vote)

 ACTION: The Town Council approved Resolution 21-73 to accept the open space, access and parking easements at Brookview Condominium located off Pond Street. Approved 9-0.
