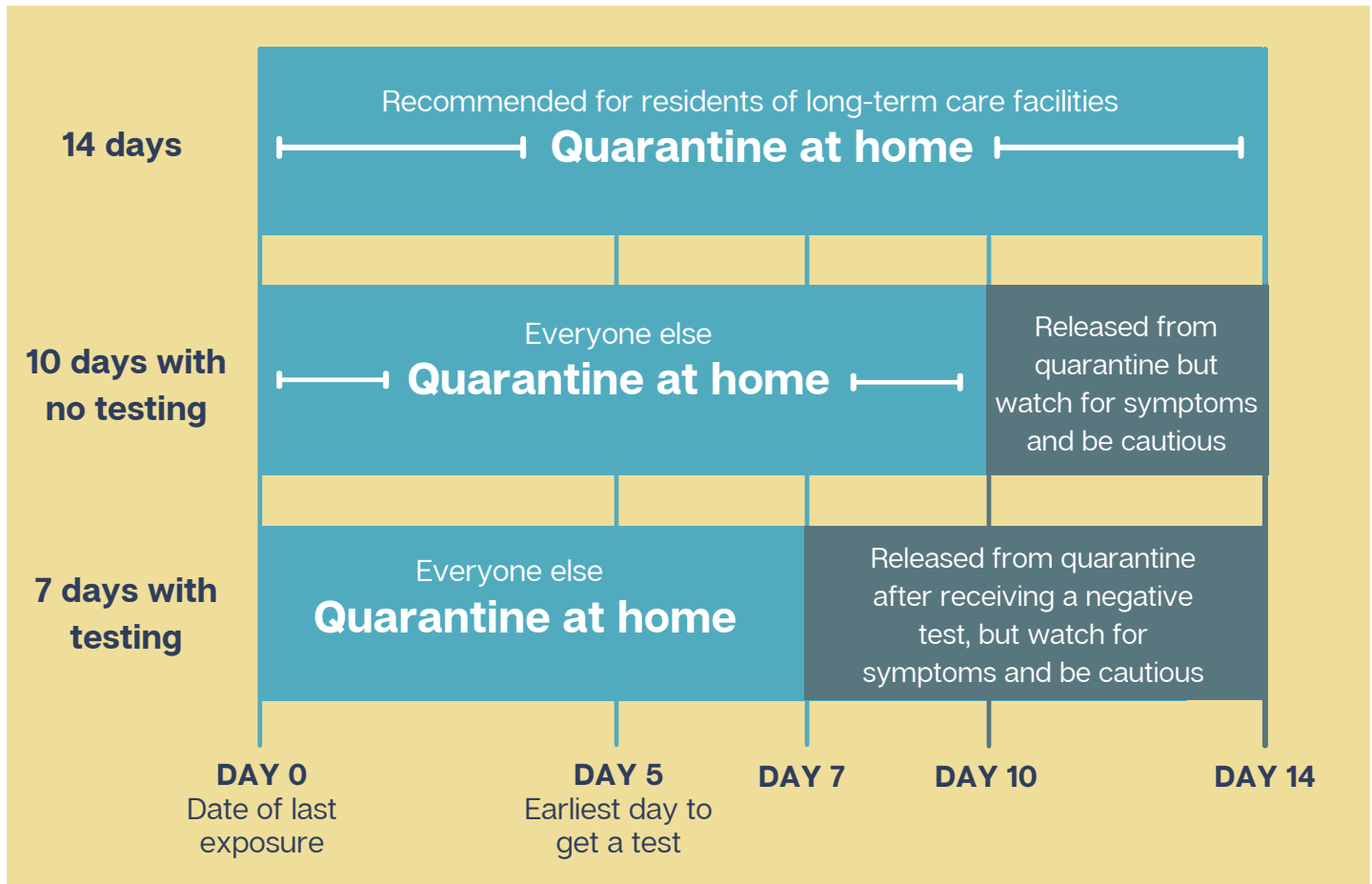


# Close Contact Quarantine Requirements

## Quarantine if you have been in close contact with someone with COVID-19.

Close contact means you've been within 6 feet of someone with COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more in a 24 hour period.



**The Franklin Health Department recommends all close contacts of people with COVID-19 get tested on day 5 of quarantine or later.**

If you get symptoms of COVID-19, isolate at home, call your healthcare provider and get a COVID-19 test.

The CDC continues to endorse 14-day quarantine as the safest protocol but has released new data and information to allow public health officials to modify policies based on local conditions and needs.
