




E SITE #5 FRANKLIN



Location: Panther Way North of the Franklin **Police Station**


Water Source: Impervious surface (16,200 sq ft of roadway) Stormwater flows along roadway into catchbasin and is then piped into the rain garden.




Rain Garden Size: 40,900 cu ft Designed to hold water from a 100 year storm.





(shrubs), Switchgrass, Daylily & Coneflower (perennials)






Runoff from surrounding imprevious area; playground and paved walkway (9,343 sq ft)


