### IMPORTANT PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

All requests for field inspections require at least 24-hour advance notice. The supervisor overseeing installations must be present during all inspections.

To avoid errors and omissions during construction, installers must work from plans stamped and approved by the Franklin Health Department.

A sieve analysis is required for all septic gravel used by the system installer.

The Town of Franklin Health Department does not allow installation of septic systems from January 1<sup>st</sup> to March 31<sup>st</sup> each calendar year.

I hereby certify that I have read and fully understand the subsurface sewage disposal system requirements of the Town of Franklin Health Department and the State Environmental Code 310 CMR 15.000, Title V, and that I agree to fully comply with said regulations. I further certify that the information provided on this application is complete and true, and I acknowledge that non-compliance with the Town of Franklin Health Department Regulations and/or the State Environmental Code 310 CMR 15.000, Title V may result in the suspension and/or revocation of my Septic Installer's Permit.

## All Franklin Septic Installers:

In order to ensure full compliance with Title V regulations, and in response to issues observed in the field, the Town of Franklin Health Department and the Board of Health have adopted a new article to our septic bylaws. The purpose of this article is to postpone and/or limit septic system and system component installations between January 1 and April 1. A copy of the complete article can be viewed at the Franklin Health Department office during normal business hours.

As a reminder we will continue to strictly enforce the following existing Health Department policies:

- All requests for Health Department field inspections will require at least **24-hour** advance notice.
- A sieve analysis must be provided to the Health Department for all systems requiring an over dig with fill, prior to placement. Systems using native onsite gravel will also be subject to a sieve analysis as necessary.
- All stone must be sized per regulation and be **double-washed** as required. Contaminated stone will not be allowed and will be **ordered removed if in place**.
- The system installer must strictly adhere to the design plan as approved by the Franklin Health Department. **Field change to the design by the installer without approval from the Health Department Director and the design engineer are not acceptable and will result in sanctions.** All system installers must be in possession of an **approved** plan stamped by the Franklin Health Department at the time of installation.
