Budget Hearing Process

Our Town budget is approved over a two-night process with public hearings. There will be an opportunity for resident questions/comments both evenings. The Town Council votes at the conclusion of the hearings, to adopt the annual budget.



What to Expect

Town Councillors, the Town Administrator, Superintendent, School Committee, Department Heads and many other Town of Franklin employees/staff will be in attendance.

The **agenda** will be followed and budget information is available on our website at **www.franklinma.com/town-budget**. We are asking the public to bring their own hard copy of budget documents. While all documents are available online, please be aware that wifi service may be difficult to access at the stadium.

Seating for the community will be available on the bleachers and in nearby open field areas. Space in the bleachers will be limited, and all areas should observe **social distancing guidelines**. Feel free to bring lawn chairs or a blanket to sit on if you prefer.

The P.A. system/microphone will be available for citizens' comments/questions.

The concession stand bathrooms will be available.

Please bring a mask, as well as a water bottle, bug spray, sunscreen and anything else that will make the evening(s) more comfortable for you.
