My name is Mike Lobo – my family & I have lived at 15 Matthew Drive since 1996. We are abutters of the Del Carte property – and members of St. John's church. My wife Margaret's family is originally from Franklin – her great grandfather was actually a rector at St. John's about a hundred years ago. She and I are military brats – and settled in Franklin where we raised two children.

We support the development project.

As the church Property & Grounds committee chair from 1999-2015 – the conversation about the property within the church has taken many twists and turns over the years – ranging from leasing land to various industries, selling to developers or working with a company like TCB to create an asset for the town. The church is blessed with land that we would like to develop to help those in need of affordable housing.
